With the addition of a “Refresh License” button in the Web and Console Administrative Interface, IMail customers will find it easier to refresh their licenses. The added button eliminates the need for an additional login and also acts as a reminder for customers whose licenses are about to expire.

Just a few weeks ago, Ipswitch also released a free administrative utility pack to all existing customers, again focused on making IMail Server administration as easy as possible. Allen adds, “Many companies practice one-way communication with their customers. We take a different stance. We value our customers’ voice and incorporate it into everything that we do.”
